At the request of Hezekiah Reeves the following Deed was recorded this 15th day of
February anno Domini 1790.

This Indenture made this fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord
Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety between Courtney Ashkin of Charles
County in the state of Maryland of the one part and Hezekiah Reeves Planter in Charles
County in the said state of the other part Witnesseth that for a tid in Consideration of
the sum of one Hundred and fifty pounds Current Money of the said State to the said
^{in hand by the said Hezekiah Reeves before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt}
^{whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Courtney Ashkin}
Courtney Ashkin hath granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and
by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and Confirm unto the said
Hezekiah Reeves his Heirs and Assigns forever in fee simple two tracts or parcels of
Land being or supposed to be parts of a tract of Land known or commonly called
Jordan lying and being in Charles County and where the said Courtney Ashkin
now or lately did reside and which was devised to him in the said Courtney Ashkin
by a certain Rebecca Ashkin and also for that part of a tract of Land sold by
a certain John Ashkin unto Hezekiah Reeves containing in the two tracts or
parcels of Land one hundred and sixty nine acres more or less and the two
said tracts of Land are bounded or described as follows to wit, Beginning at a
bounded Hickory Standing on the side of a hill and running thence west
south west two hundred & twenty perches, thence north twelve degrees west forty
four perches, thence north thirty degrees East thirty six perches, thence East North East
fifty four perches, thence East by South ninety perches, thence North Eighty two degrees
East fifty perches, thence East South East forty four perches, thence South by East
half degree East forty perches, thence with a straight line to the first beginning
Containing by estimation sixty nine acres, the other tract or parcel of Land begin-
ning at John Smiths lower Corner tree being a white oak Standing in the mouth
of a small Branch running thence west South west one hundred & sixty perches
to a marked Hickory Standing upon the side of a hill near a small Branch thence
north one hundred perches to a red oak Standing on the side of a Branch thence
East north East one hundred & sixty perches to a marked Hickory Standing in a Valley
from thence with a direct line drawn to the first bound tree Containing one hundred
acres more or less to have and to hold the said Tracts or parcels of Land called Jordan
according and agreeably to the metes and bounds aforesaid with all ways of its
